The European Union stresses that it supports all efforts to meaningful discussion concerning the topic of the economy of climate change mitigation and adaptation (ECC) with international trade- and commerce-related aspects, regulatory regimes and the involvement of facilities and institutions pursuant to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).

In the section Notes

The European Union believe that it is inevitable to solve the problem of economic aspects of climate change as one of the main contemporary global challenges. Hence we welcome the initiative of the *Forum for 21st Century* to update the Kyoto-established platform. We appreciate the meaningful discussion initiated by the *Forum for 21st Century* and especially the results achieved. We fully agree with the statement, that "the United Nations has reached an unprecedented evolutionary stage of global awareness, responsibility and cooperation in the past decades."
